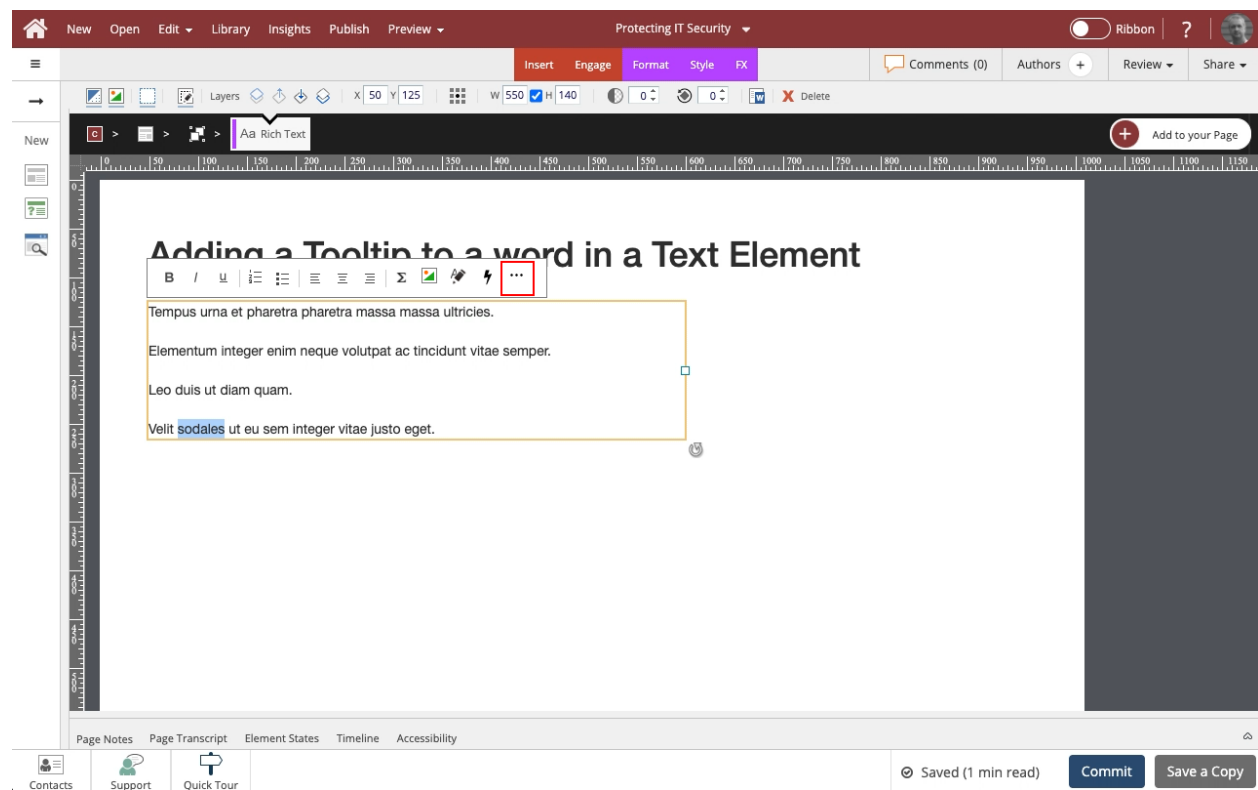

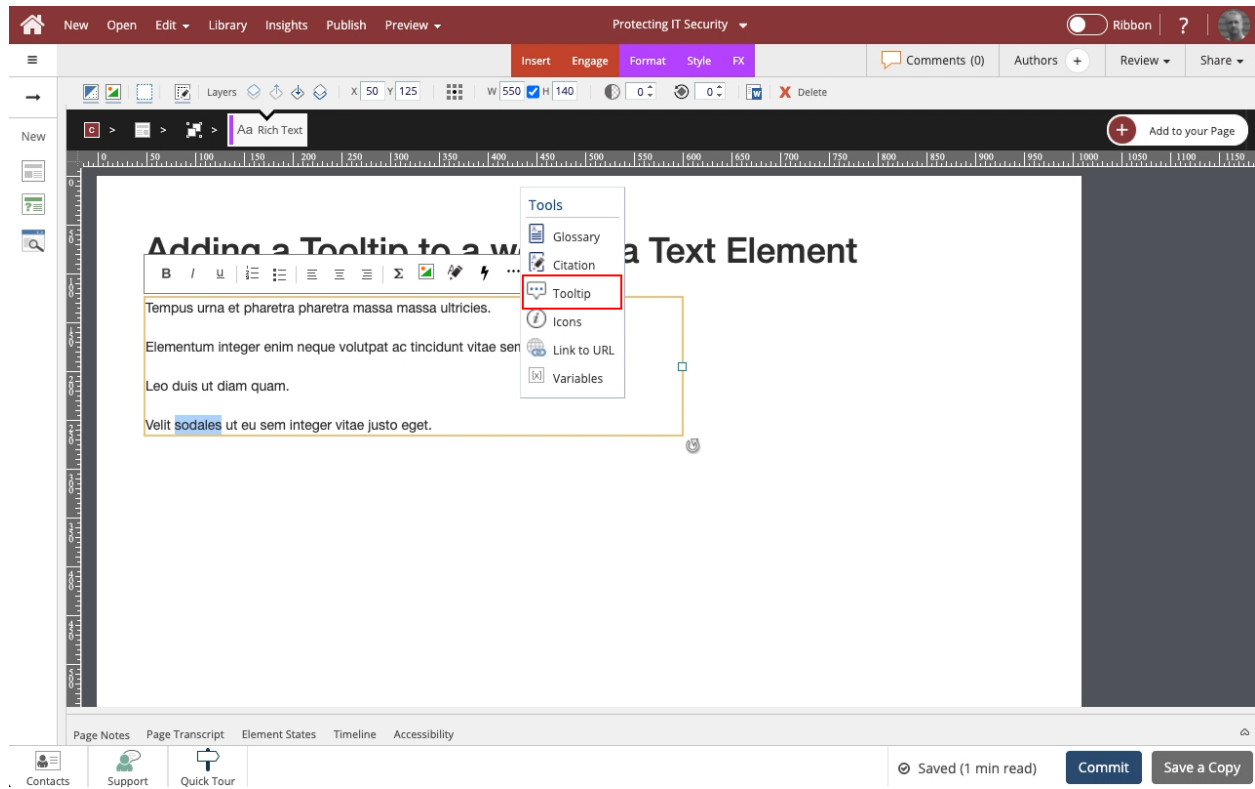
## Add a Tooltip to a word in a Text element

1. When working in a Text Element, select the word that you wish to apply the Tooltip to then select the three-dot menu on the text editing mini tool bar.

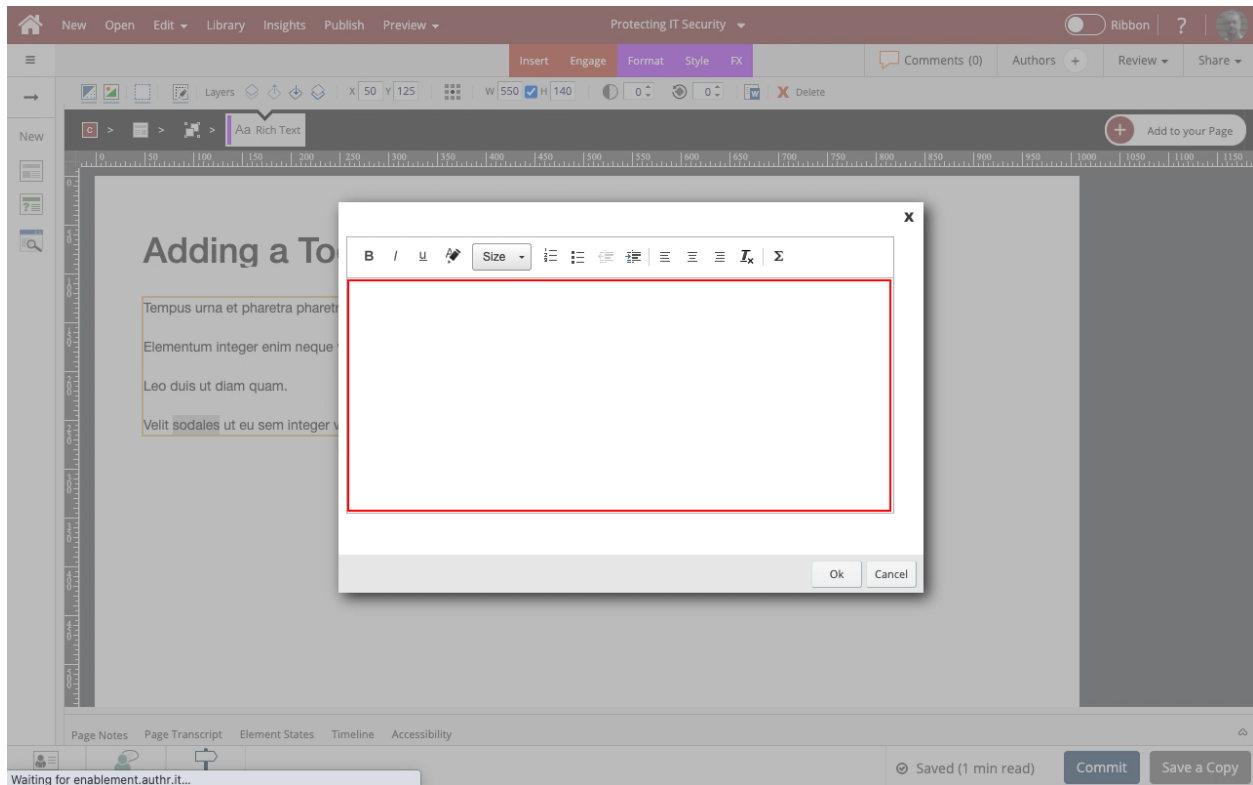
### 2. Select Tooltip.

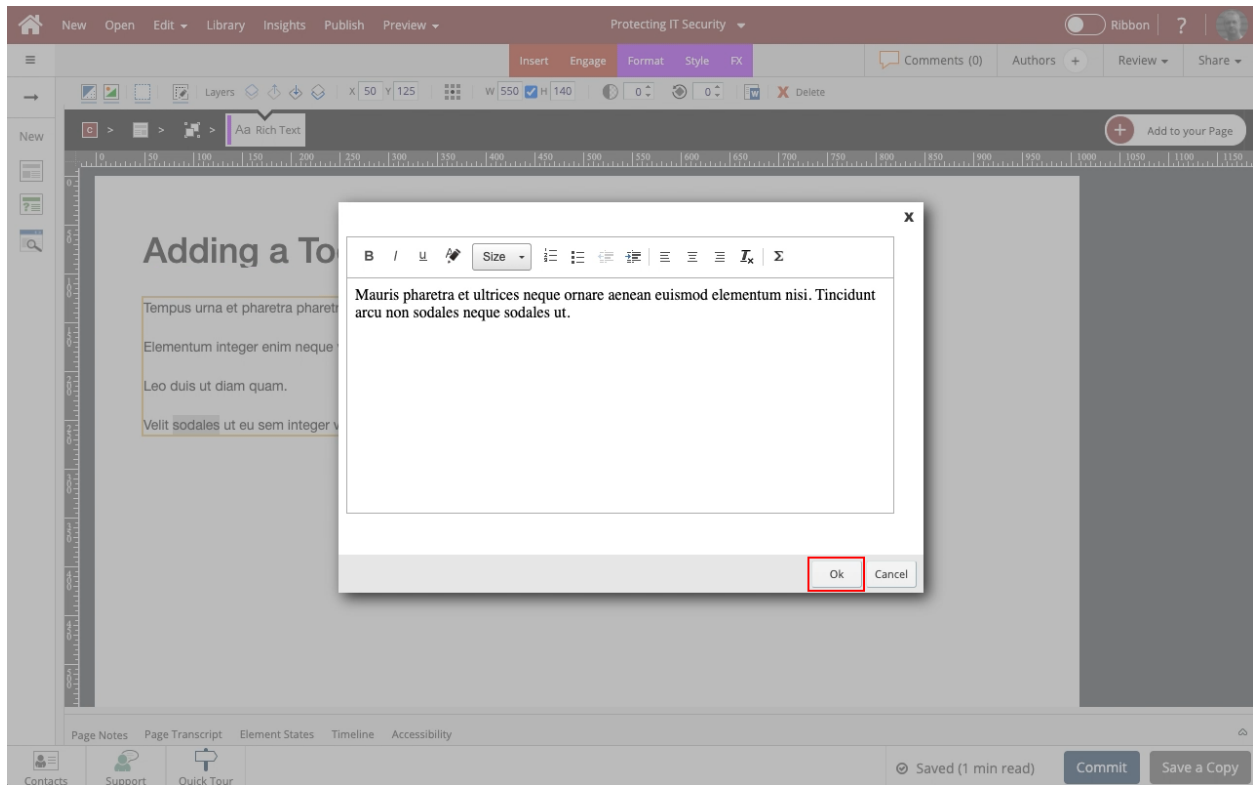

3. The tooltip panel will open. Select the text edit area and we'll add tooltip text for you.




## Add a Tooltip to a word in a Text element

## Add a Tooltip to a word in a Text element


5. After clicking Ok, you are still in edit mode in the text element on the page. Select outside of the element to leave editing mode and save the changes to the text element.
