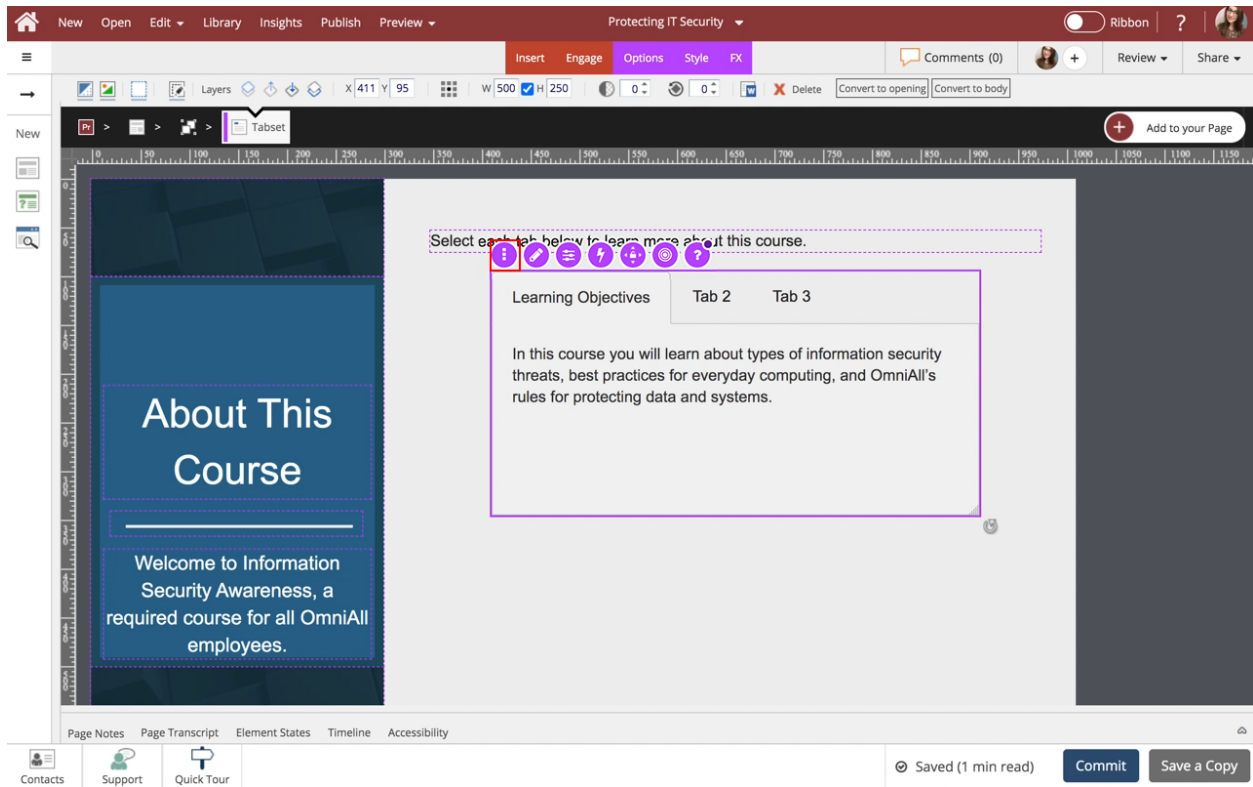
## Format a Tab Set Component

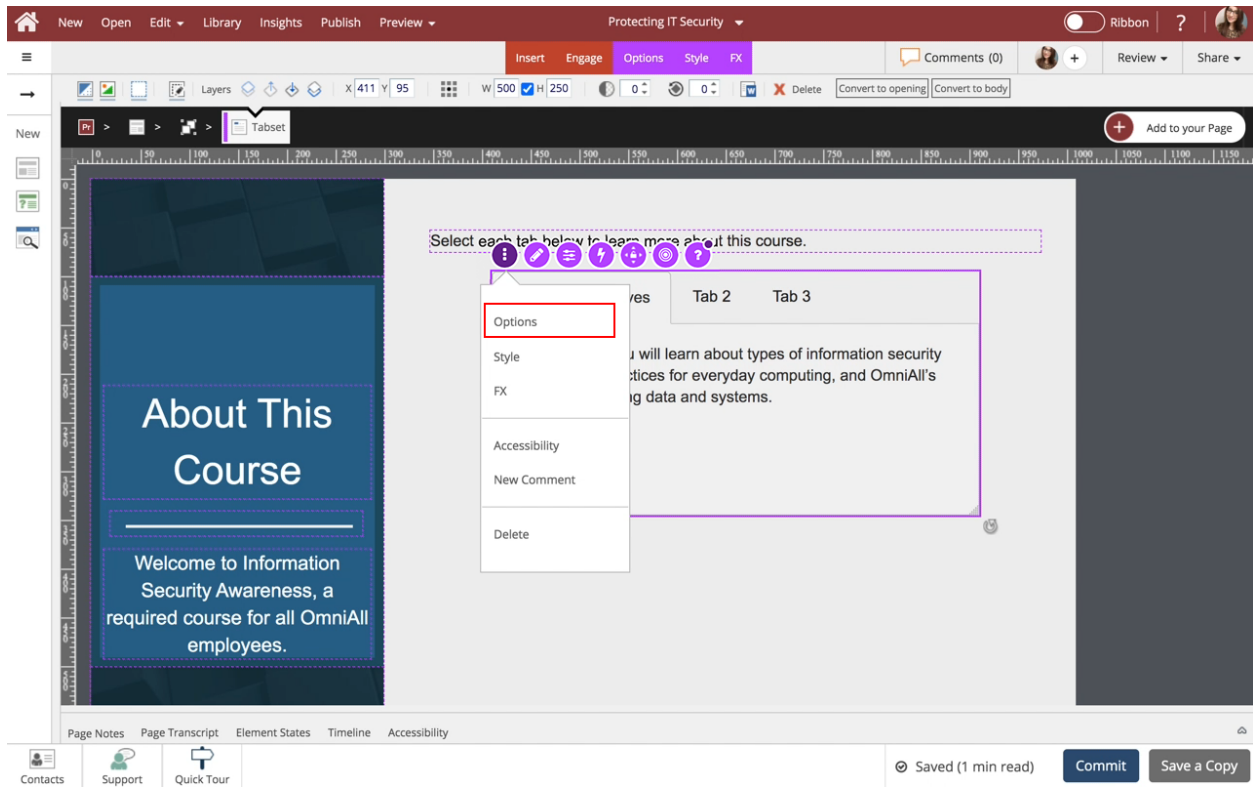

2. Select the Three-Dot Menu in the Element Controls toolbar.



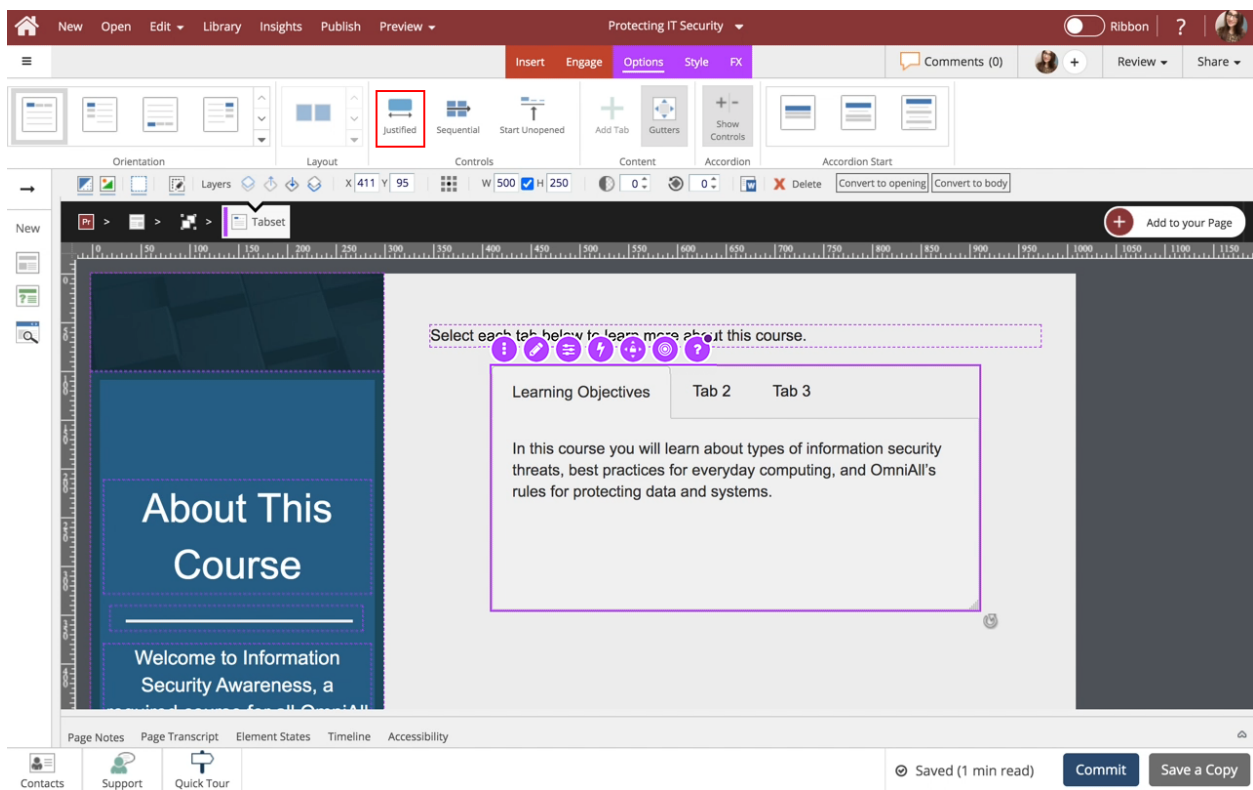

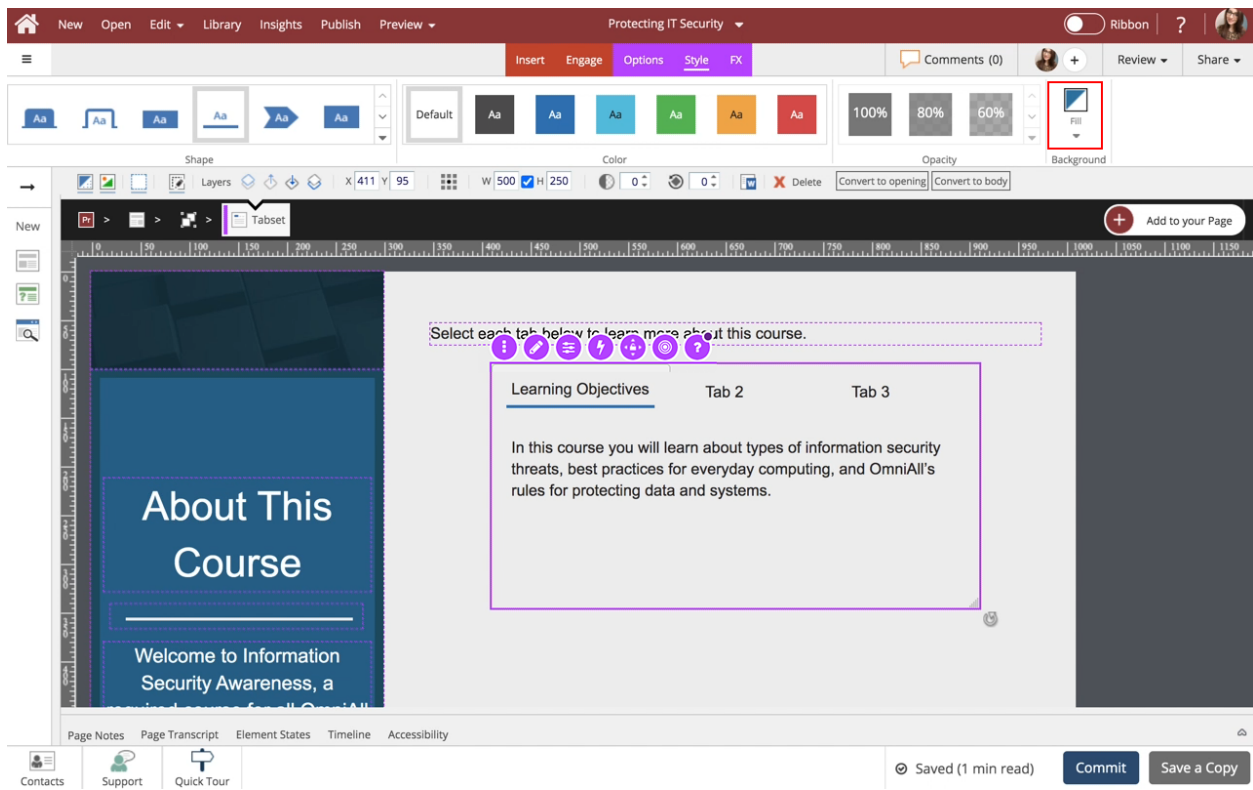

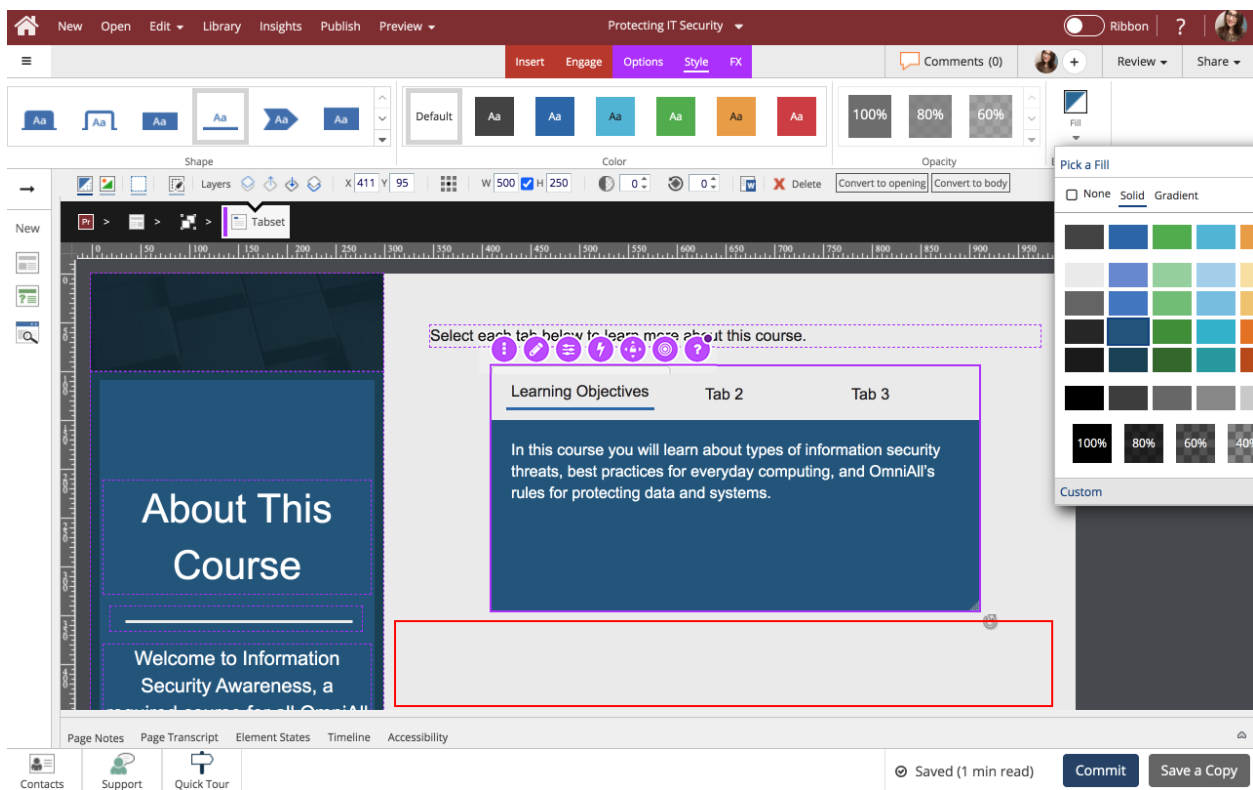
