



1. Select the Image on the page.




2. Select the + icon.




3. The Add Elements side panel shows.


Select Marker.




4. The Marker is added to the Image. To edit the Marker ext, select the Pencil icon.



5. Select the Text area to edit the Marker text. You can style the text using the format tab above the text area.




6. Select Ok.
